The candidate should have a M.B.B.S degree with permanent registration with medical council and MD or post graduate diploma in clinical specialty and a long-term commitment to palliative care. Preference will be given for post graduate qualification in pediatrics. Preference will also be given to a candidate applying from the state of Andhra Pradesh.

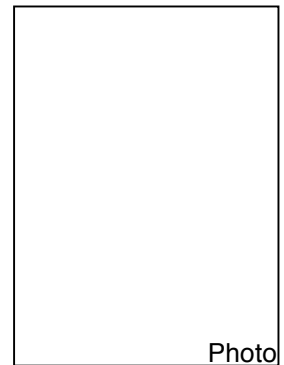

 - 5) Amount of time the applicant would be able to work in the field of pediatric pain medicine & palliative care upon his/her return from this course
- (D) A letter from the Dean, Department Chair, or similar institutional leader indicating a commitment to the applicant and his/her career goals, institutional support for the applicant's activities in the field of pediatric pain and palliative care, if applicable.
