

Cancer Pension

Procedure for Applying for the Kerala Government's Cancer Pension

Introduction

A welfare scheme (pension scheme) has been implemented by the Government of Kerala to provide financial assistance to cancer patients. The details regarding eligibility, documents required, and the procedure to apply online are given below.

Where/How to Apply?

You can apply for the Cancer Pension:

- Through any Akshaya Centre
- Online through: <https://landrevenue.kerala.gov.in>

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Be a resident of Kerala
- Have an annual income below ₹2,00,000 (two lakh rupees)
- If the applicant is a minor or a person with an intellectual disability, their parent or, in their absence, a legally appointed guardian can submit the application on their behalf with their permanent address.

Documents Required (Scan carefully before uploading)

- Medical certificate issued within the last 6 months by the doctor treating the applicant
- Ration card (the page showing the applicant's name)
- Aadhaar card
- Bank passbook (first page showing name and account details)
- Income certificate issued by the respective village office

To register in the Citizen Service Platform?

1. Visit <https://landrevenue.kerala.gov.in/>
2. Click on "[Pensions](#)"
3. The "Citizen Service Platform" will open
4. If you already have an account, log in using your mobile number and enter the OTP received via SMS
5. If you already have an account, log in using your mobile number and the OTP sent via SMS
6. If you don't have an account or are a new user, select "Create an Account" and then:
 - Enter your name and mobile number
 - Enter the 6-digit verification code received via SMS
 - Fill in other personal details
7. Click "Submit"

Procedure to Submit the Application Online:

1. Log in/register at <https://landrevenue.kerala.gov.in>
2. Go to the "[Pensions](#)" section
3. Click "Apply Now" next to "കൃഷ്ണൻ രാജിമുക്ക് പെൻഷൻ പദ്ധതി"
4. Fill in the required personal and bank details
5. Upload the necessary supporting documents
6. Submit the application

Verification and Approval of the Application

- Officials at the Village Office or Taluk Office will verify the application details.
- If necessary, they may conduct a home visit to confirm the information provided.
- Once approved, the pension will be sanctioned, and the amount will be directly credited to the



applicant's bank account.

Pension Amount

- The current monthly pension amount is ₹1,400 (subject to change as per government regulations).
- The usual processing time for sanctioning the pension is between 15 days to 2 months.

Note: If required, the application for pension renewal must be resubmitted one year after the initial approval date by repeating the procedure described above.
